Exclusion Policy for Illness - Back to school sometimes mean back to illness – we have had quite a few absences due to illness the past few weeks. We do have to follow the provincial guidelines for illness. If a child has a fever they are to stay home from school until they are fever free, without fever reducing medications for 24 hours, if they are vomiting or have diarrhea they do have to stay home for 48 hours past their last episode.

Instructional Time: Our instruction time begins at 8:25. Students are to be at school, ready to learn at this time. When students arrive after 8:25, they are missing out on important instruction.
