Black History Month –

Seaside Park will be hosting two guest speakers this month to educate our students about the importance of Black History Month. On Feb. 20th Ms. Naomi Leslie will be visiting our school to speak with our students. Ms. Leslie is a direct descendant of the Black Loyalist who helped build Saint John. Her goal is for every student to understand that Black history is Canadian history.

On Feb. 23rd we will welcome Mr. Wesley Williams, also known as Maestro Fresh Wes, to Seaside Park. Maestro Fresh Wes will be discussing the importance of respecting others, demonstrating kindness to those we interact with each day and the importance of setting goals for your life.

After a new student at their school was bullied for wearing a pink shirt, two grade 12 students bought 50 pink shirts and encouraged their classmates to wear pink. We are encouraging all of our staff and students to wear pink and demonstrate kindness and acceptance on February 28th.
