Attendance Matters – Our attendance policy is in place so that we can help encourage and support our students in being at school each day. If your child has missed 5 days of school, please know that their homeroom teacher will be reaching out to see how we can support you. Once your child misses 10 days of school, an attendance letter will be emailed or mailed reminding you about your child's attendance. At 15 days an administrator will call to have a conversation on how we
