

PSSC MEETING Minutes – 10-11 am, Thursday, December 12th, 2019

- Call to order
- 10-year Provincial Education Plan – K-5 Focus now with an emphasis on K-5 literacy and math. We have Debbie Smith and Lana Hawkins working with Mr. Anderson and Mrs. Betts on a request basis. Both teachers have put forth proposals and will get that support. In math, Brent and Abbie are working on Math Running Records with Lana and will present to the rest of the staff on the Jan 6 PL day.
- Lock downs and Hold & Secure – Mr. Davis explained to the members the responsibilities of parents, families and community members in the case of lock downs and Hold and Secures. If we were to ever be in one of these situations, parents, families and community members need to stay away from the school and surrounding areas so that emergency personnel can have easy access to our building. As well, phone contact needs to be kept to a minimum during these sensitive times.
- Provincial Assessments – Grade 4 & 6 results – Both of these groups were above the district and provincial averages.
- 2019-2020 School Improvement Plan – Review Goals – This will be reviewed by staff on Jan. 6th . We are looking at making changes with our math goals moving forward.
- Children’s Stage Adventures – Jan 20th – 24th – Volunteers needed – Jane and Gary have volunteered to house the group.
- Whoville Dinner – Wednesday, December 18th – Volunteers needed. Jolene has volunteered to help.
- Open Q&A – members are still frustrated with our staffing issues and class combinations. Some members are going to begin to investigate other schools in our province with the same combinations/class sizes. They all agree that 3 grades should never be combined and that the teachers collective agreement needs to be changed to address this issue.
