

PSSC MEETING Minutes– 9-10am, Thursday, May 9th, 2019

- Call to order
 - Action Items from last meeting – All teaching staff are now trained in ‘Zones of Regulation’ and we will roll it our school wide in the fall. Some teachers may already be using the terminology. The school has purchased resources for each classroom. This program allows students to self-regulate their emotions and behaviours.
 - 2019-2020 Staffing – Staffing is not yet complete. We know we will have 4 classroom teachers. As far as we know, all current staff will remain intact. We will have a K/1/2 (12), 3/4 (15), 5/6 (15), 7/8 (12). EA allotment still unknown. There was little discussion at this time as staffing is still in the early stages.
 - Provincial Assessments – May/June 2019 – Grade 2 Provincial Reading Assessment (removed), Grade 4 Provincial Field testing in English, Math and Science – May 22-June 1, Grade 6 Provincial Assessment in English, PIF, Math and Science – May 28-June 8
 - Children’s Stage Adventures – May 27-31 – This was rescheduled from the winter where we had a few snow days. Members came forward to volunteer.
 - School transition day – June 5th – Grade 8’s to FMHS, new K’s in the building, everyone else moves up a grade. We will send invitations out to our pre-K’s. This always proves to be a positive day and an easy transition as the pre-K’s have been in our building fairly often for a variety of activities.
 - School field trip – Tuesday, June 18th, – Irving Nature Park in West Saint John. Mr. Anderson is coordinating this again for us. Last year proved to be a great day. Members shared their approval, and some volunteered to chaperone.
