The ***Tell Them From Me*** online survey tool will give your school and the province information to help make improvements.


In March and April, all students in Grades 4 – 12 will complete the online survey. A new parent survey will also be available online and available on paper for your convenience.

Safety/Respect/Responsibility Bracelet Program

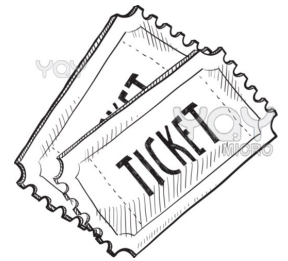
Next week's theme:
