#### **Math Facts**

Math facts are practiced and assessed on a regular basis in our math classes. These are the year-end expectations for each grade which can and should be practiced at home nightly:

- Grade K Must be able to subatize numbers to 10
- ${f Grade\ 1}$  Must be able to add and subtract numbers with answers to 20
- **Grade 2** Must be able to add and subtract with numbers up to 18+18 and corresponding subtraction
- **Grade 3** Must be able to multiply up to 5 x 5 and related division
- Grade 4 Must be able to multiply up to 9 x 9 and related division
- $\boldsymbol{Grade}\ \boldsymbol{5}$  Must be able to multiply up to 9 x 9 and related division
- $Middle\ level$  Mastery of facts up to 12 x 12 and related division
