

## K-2 School Supplies for 2019-2020

- Please purchase the school supplies listed below, and **do not** write the student's name on them for K-2 (except for the headphones and sneakers).
- Please place all of your child's school supplies in a plastic bag (Save-Easy) and label the bag with his or her name.
- If possible, drop the bag of supplies off to your child's homeroom teacher the week before school opens in September (i.e. the week before Labour Day; teachers will be at school for meetings that week).
  
- 1 packages of 24 crayons (We prefer Crayola.)
- 1 packages of 10 washable markers (We prefer Crayola.)
- 1 package of pencil crayons
- 10 duotangs (2 each of red, blue, green, yellow, and orange)
- 1 package of pencils
- 3 large glue sticks
- 1 pair of scissors
- 1 package of 4 Hilroy scribblers (32 pages)
- 1 white vinyl eraser
- 1 Campfire Notebook
- 1 box of Large Ziploc Freezer Bags (not easy zipper)

- 4 black white board markers (dry erase – low odor please; for student use on small white boards) (We prefer Expo)

**GMCS Grades 9-12 School Supply List—2019-2010**

**ALL STUDENTS IN HIGH SCHOOL SHOULD HAVE A USB DRIVE TO STORE DOCUMENTS! They should own basic project supplies: scissors, glue stick, black sharpie, markers or pencil crayons.**

English 9, 10, 112- Loose leaf paper, a binder or duotang (there will be handouts), separate notebook and journal (this can be just a divider in the binder/duotang), blue or black pens

English 113, English 122 or 123- 1 “ binder with pocket or a pocket insert to hold loose sheets, looseleaf paper, blue or black pens, dryliner, reinforcer circles (to repair holes in sheets), highlighter

Journalism 120- 1” binder with looseleaf, blue/or black pens

Modern History 112/113/ Indigenous Studies 120 - Loose leaf paper, a binder or duotang (there will be handouts), separate notebook and journal (this can be just a divider in the binder/duotang), blue or black pens. History 1113 needs two pieces of Bristol board as well.

Law 120 or Canadian Women in History 120-1 “ binder with pocket or a pocket insert to hold loose sheets, looseleaf paper, blue or black pens, dryliner, reinforcer circles (to repair holes in sheets), highlighter

SS 9 or History 10- 1” binder with looseleaf, blue or black pens, highlighter

Math 9- binder, dividers, rulers, scientific calculator, pens and pencils, erasers, highlighter, looseleaf

Math 10 or Financial Workplace Math 11 or Foundations Math 11- 3 ring binder, pencil, eraser, ruler, scientific calculator (not just your cell phone, graph paper

Pre-calculus 12 A, 12B, or Calculus 120- 1” binder, looseleaf, graph paper, scientific calculator, ruler

Science 9 or 10 - 1” binder, looseleaf, dividers, scientific calculator, pencils, eraser, blue or black pens

Physics 11, Physics 12, or Biology 112- binder, dividers, rulers, scientific calculator, pens and pencils, erasers, highlighter, looseleaf, protractor, one duotang with inner pocket

Environmental Science 120- blue or black pens, a binder with looseleaf or notebook with a pocket

BBT 10 (grade 9s)- 3 ring binder with looseleaf, pens and pencils

French 9 and French 10- 1” binder, loose-leaf and some white computer paper, pencils and pens
