

GMCS High School School Supply List- 2018-19

English 9 or English 112- loose leaf paper, a binder or duotang (there will be handouts), separate notebook and journal (This can be just a divider in the binder/duotang), blue or black pens

English 10, English 113, 122 or 123- Binder, looseleaf, small journal (dollar store), blue or black pens

Modern History 113 or Social Studies 9- Loose leaf paper, a binder or duotang (there will be handouts), blue or black pens, two pieces of Bristol board

History 10, Music 10, Physical Geography 110, Hospitality and Tourism 110, PDCP 9- binder, looseleaf, blue or black pens.

Math 9, Math 10 NRF and GMF or Math 11 Financial and Workplace Math, Foundations Math 11, Pre-calculus 11, Pre-calculus 12- Binder with looseleaf, Scientific Calculator with Sin/Cos/Tan functions (not just their cell phone), a ruler, a small bundle of graph paper that will be collected by the teacher and kept in the classroom, pencils/erasers (math done in pen will not be accepted).

BBT 9/10 (Broad Based Technology)- 3 Ring Binder (that will be left in the Tech Lab all the time) and earbuds/headphones

Residential Finish, Framing and Sheathing, Metals Fabrication, Metals Processing- Z87.1 rated (or better) safety glasses, rigid toe work boots that can be left at school, Recommended: Coveralls (that can be left at school)

Nutrition 120- binder, pens (blue or black ink), looseleaf, highlighter, 1 piece of Bristol board

Media Studies 120 or Individual & Family Dynamics 120- binder, divider, looseleaf, project supplies

Theatre Arts 120-\$20 materials fee – give to Ms. Ingalls

Visual Arts 10, 11 or Graphic Arts 11- \$10 materials fee- give to Ms. Griffin

Reading Tutor 120- Binder, looseleaf, index cards

Culinary 110 and Culinary 120- \$20 materials fee- give to Ms. Fitzsimmons plus 2”binder, looseleaf, dividers

French 9 or 10- pens, binder, duotang, looseleaf, pens (blue or black)

French 11- ½” binder, looseleaf, 1 duotang, pens (blue or black)

Phys. Ed 9 or 10- Clean inside sneakers and clothing appropriate for Phys. Ed, duotang with looseleaf, pens

Biology 112, Biology 122, Chemistry 112, Chemistry 122- 1" binder, looseleaf, dividers, 1 duotang with an inner pocket, pens (blue or black ink), pencils

Science 9 or 10- ruler, binder, calculator, pencils, erasers, pen, looseleaf
