Find an image you like (a photo or a hand drawn image). Save the image or photograph it with a camera or cell phone.

Find a way to “posterize” or make your design into a one or two color stencil. You might have to do some research on this.



Using Photoshop:

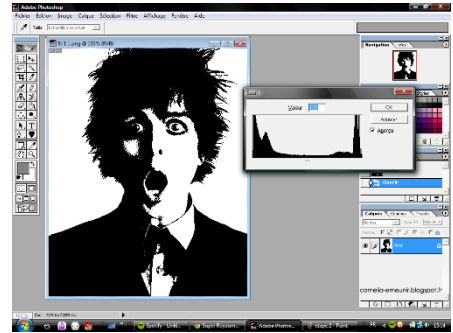
Open the image in Photoshop.

Enhance--adjust---remove color (to make black and white)

Enhance---brightness contrast--punch up contrast as high as possible.

Next use a filter such as "cutout" or "stamp" to make your image look like a stamp.

Center your design on a white background. Save it as a JPEG and email it to me.
