- In keeping with best practice, several teachers are choosing to pool the students' school supplies to create community supplies for all students' use. For this reason, please do not put your child's name on school supplies.
- Each student will be required to pay a \$15 student fee. The student fee is used to cover the cost of his/her student agenda and assist with other costs such as skating, school bus trips, etc.
- Your child will need a book bag and a pair of sneakers to be worn indoors. It is best if your child's name can be on these items. Please note to avoid shoes that leave black marks on the floor. Also, Phys Ed guidelines require that the students wear sneakers that have Velcro or laces for their safety (no slip on's please). Students should be able to tie their sneakers independently.
- School will begin for all students in grades 1-5 on Tuesday, September 3. Kindergarten students will have a split entry – half of the students will come on September 3 and half will begin on September 4 with all kindergarten students coming on September 5 and onward. Families of Kindergarten students will receive a letter by mail early in July to let them know which day their child begins school.
