- ***We are trying a new system in kindergarten only for this year – parents can choose to provide the listed items or parents can pay a \$30 school supply fee and the school will purchase the listed supplies (excluding the bold print items).**
- In keeping with best practice, several teachers are choosing to pool the students' school supplies to create community supplies for all students' use. For this reason, please do not put your child's name on school supply items. If you or your child has "special" items, we encourage that these items be kept at home for use on special projects.
- Each student will need \$5 to cover the cost of his/her student agenda. Your PSSC has worked hard to get the cost of this communication tool to a minimal amount.
- Your child will need a book bag and a pair of sneakers to be worn indoors. It's best if your child's name can be on these items.
- School will begin for all students in grades 1-5 on Tuesday September 2. Kindergarten students will have a split entry – half of the students will come on September 2 and half will begin on September 3 with all kindergarten students coming on September 4 and onward. Families of Kindergarten students will receive a letter by mail early in July to let them know which day their child begins school.
