- Your child will need a book bag and a pair of sneakers to be worn indoors. It's best if your child's name can be on these items.
- School will begin for all students in grades 1-5 on Tuesday September 2. Kindergarten students will have a split entry half of the students will come on September 2 and half will begin on September 3 with all kindergarten students coming on September 4 and onward. Families of Kindergarten students will receive a letter by mail early in July to let them know which day their child begins school.
