What is myBluePrint?

MyBlueprint is a mobile-friendly education and career/life planning resource used by counsellors and teachers to meet learning outcomes and engage students in planning for their future.

MyBlueprint is a teaching and learning tool. The features include:

- Focusing on the Process of Learning
- Personalized Learning experiences
- Encouraging self-assessment and reflection
- FREE Digital Portfolio building to collect evidence of learning, Global Competence, and for Future Ready Planning
- Giving teachers ability to create custom class activities
- Meeting curriculum and learning outcomes
- Encouraging parent engagement through parent portal
- 100+lesson plans, activities and resources

What is this menu and what is the goal?

It is proposed that all middle school principals be provided the following menu of options to introduce their staff to myBlueprint. An effort will be made to reach each middle school with a **minimum of one** of the following options.

The personalization lead, although not responsible for all training options, will work with EECD staff to track and encourage participation from all ASD-S middle schools.
