How to Make a Shoebox

This holiday season, fill a standard-sized, decorated Shoebox with gifts and essentials that any woman might enjoy. The top and bottom of your Shoebox must be wrapped separately so that it can be opened for inspection (or use a decorative box!) Gifts may include necessities and little luxuries that many women do not have access to or the means to purchase during a difficult time. The main objective of a Shoebox is to help its recipient feel special, worthy, and cared for.

<u>Perfect Jtems to Include</u>

- · A gift card (affordable & accessible locations)
- · Warm accessories like mitts, scarf, hat, socks
- · Body lotion, hand lotion, body wash, facial cleanser, face mask
- · Toothbrush & toothpaste, lip balm, mints, gum
- · Shampoo, conditioner, hair brush
- Cosmetics like nail polish, mascara, eye liner, eye shadow, lipgloss
- · Something sweet, nut-free chocolate, candy
- Purse-sized Kleenex, small cosmetic bag, journal, pens
- A thoughtful and supportive message

What to Leave Out

- · Used goods , unpackaged items, or hotel/free samples
- Sized clothing (i.e. S, M, L, XL)
- Products containing alcohol (i.e. mouthwash, hand sanitizer)
- Candles
- Foundations, concealers or any product for a specific skin tone or hair
- Tampons & sanitary napkins
- Razors
