Attached is the ENDS #5 ASD-S Improvement Plan Status Report 2019, which lists the strategies that were adopted with the District Improvement Plan (DIP) and the outcomes achieved, those in progress and a statement about the overall "health" of the goals. This year the focus has been professional learning for guidance counsellors, school staff as well as custodians, and District office staff. ASD-S hosted a middle school GSA Conference with funding for school based follow-up projects. We supported students attending the Pride in Education Conference in Fredericton and will be well represented at the national "Outshine" Conference in May.
