### Communication to Pilot School & Curriculum Team

### • This initiative is to align our collective work in supporting:

- END Policy 2: "To demonstrate continuous improvement toward meeting provincial targets in literacy, numeracy, science (English and French Immersion) and to improve learning in and application of the arts, trades and technology."
- Goal 2.2: "To have high functioning Professional Learning Communities at the district and in all schools / early learning centers."
- Strategies: "Create and implement a process improvement plan to measure the overall functioning of professional learning communities in schools.

# • Establishment of a ASD-S Guiding Coalition PLC Team

- The guiding coalition team will consist of 7 principals, 7 core leadership team members, 12 subject coordinators, 1 alignment champion, and 1 director of curriculum.
- The pilot school stakeholders in collaboration with the district stakeholders will define the ASD-S standard work regarding PLCs.

# • Guiding Coalition PLC Team will co-construct & define:

- The purpose of the initiative
  - Mission Statement
  - Vision Statement
  - Value system
- The different elements needed in order to implement, monitor, and sustain highly functioning PLCs.
  - Differentiate the different steps within the PLC cycle.
- $\circ$   $\;$  The ASD-S PLC self-assessment measuring tool.
  - Establish administration requirements
    - Baseline
    - Trends
  - Establish district and school outcome measure
  - Establish measurement metrics to identify input measures.

### • 2 district staff members will be attached to each pilot school.

- District staff members will allocate 10 to 20 percent of their time to support the initiative.
  - Time allocation:
    - Weekly school visits Regular meetings will be scheduled in order to support the school PLC process.
    - Biweekly district calibration meetings Regular meetings will be scheduled in order to monitor progress, review the project health, and calibrate the district level work.
- District staff will support:
  - The process of PLC at the school level.
  - The growth process of educators in the school.
  - The monitoring of the project overall health.
