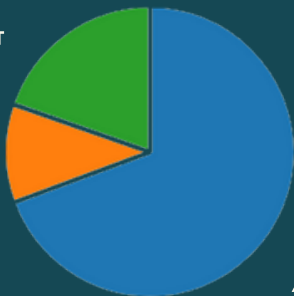

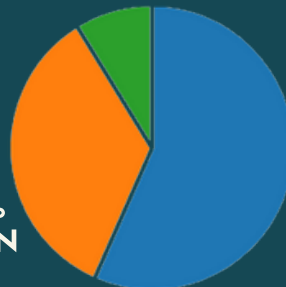

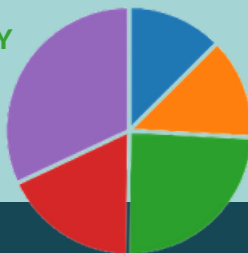

"Teams worked well given the situation but I will always still prefer to meet the teacher in person."

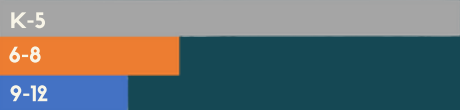
"It was easy to set up and I got a reminder in my calendar! Very convenient and worked great!"
