The SIP Framework

Schools form their SIP based teams.

SIP Team goes through all sources of data available to them to identify areas of strength and areas in need of improvement.

SIP Team creates a "data-lead sheet" to be used on the January 7th school-based SIP day.

January 7th – all staff engage in the process of determining the areas of focus for the school's SIP.

The data-lead sheet helps to guide the process and staff ultimately determine which items will have the biggest impact on student achievement within the school.
