



SCHOOL SUSTAINABILITY REVIEW and SCHEDULE OF PUBLIC CONSULTATIONS

The Anglophone South District Education Council (DEC) will host Public Consultations as per Provincial Policy 409 *Multi-Year School Infrastructure Planning* to study the sustainability of **Centennial School and Hazen-White/St. Francis School**.

Under Policy 409, the DEC will be holding two public information sessions for each school. The initial meeting will be to deliver the proposal to the public and to allow the DEC and staff to explain the process involved in a Policy 409 review and be available to answer questions about the process.

A second meeting will be scheduled in March to allow the public an opportunity to ask questions about the proposal, voice their concerns and provide feedback to the review.

The first meeting for Centennial School is scheduled for Monday, February 12, 2018 at 6:30 pm at the school.

The first meeting for Hazen-White/St. Francis School is scheduled for Tuesday, February 20, 2018 at 6:30 pm at the school.
