Anglophone Sector

Background

- 2017-18 Discontinued counting students who missed the assessment as *Below Appropriate Achievement*
- 2019-20 COVID: Only English Language Proficiency Assessment (ELPA) and Grade 12 Oral Proficiency Interview (OPI) administered
- 2020-21 COVID: English & French Second Language (FSL) Reading and Grade 10 & 12 OPI only;
- Transition to census administration began;
- Transition to online assessment began with ELPA
- 2021-22 All assessments delivered online other than 10% mode study for item analysis purposes; no assessments cancelled

Interpretation of Results

- All assessments repeated from 2020-21 have been statistically equated and results can be compared with 2021-22.

Participation

- Exemption rates for most assessments ranged between 2% and 5%, similar to last years'
- Grade 10 Post Intensive French (PIF) Reading was the exception, increased from 4.7% to 13.6%, (mostly due to increase in one district from 8.9% to 34%).
- Grade 6 OPI participation: approximately 77%
- Grade 12 OPI participation: approximately 96% with little variation among districts

Results Overall

- Greater success than anticipated
- Remained fairly stable. Of the 12 assessments seven differed by less than five percentage points from the previous year.
- Greatest decreases:
 - Grade 4 English Reading (-9.1 percentage points)
 - Grade 6 OPI - FI Grade 3 Entry (-9.1 percentage points)
 - Grade 10 PIF Reading (-7.7 percentage points)
- Increase:
 - Grade 10 FI Grade 6 Entry (+ 6.9 percentage points)







at Intermediate and Above**


