Data Snapshot Summary: 1) A review of the second report card data indicates 43% of K-2 students and 22% of 3-5 students are Below Benchmark in Writing (2019)

2) In examining CARR data 64.9% agree that "the things I learn at school are interesting to me" and 77.6% agree with the statement "what I learn at school is useful in my everyday life" (2018)

Goal: Barkers Point School will strengthen student engagement with a focus on increasing student-writing outcomes. "Student engagement is the extent to which students identify with and value schooling outcomes, have a sense of belonging to school, participate in academic and non-academic activities, strive to meet the formal requirements of schooling, and make serious personal investment in learning." (2009, Wilms, Friesen & Milton)

Indicators of Success:

- i) increased stamina
- ii) fewer attempts to avoid tasks (ie. Bathroom breaks, drinks of water)
- iii) reduced number of work refusal office referrals
- iv) teacher observation checklists indicate students on task and excited about writing
- v) students are willing/excited to share their work with their peers through Author Celebrations & Publications
- vi) quantity and quality of writing pieces indicates continual growth
- vii) student work will be celebrated on the walls and bulletin boards around the school
