Literacy: We will continue to discuss ‘Million \$ Words’ and how we need to include these words in our writing to make it more descriptive for the reader. We are introducing the spelling rule ‘i before e, except after c’ and reviewing the use of commas in lists and in dates.

Writing: This week we are completing a new independent writing piece. From this piece we will be setting new writing goals by self-assessing our writing and asking friends to give us their opinion as well.

Math: We have completed our addition and subtraction unit! Wow! What hard and enthusiastic workers we have in our classroom. This week we are going to begin our multiplication unit! The anticipation has been building and it is finally here! We will be looking at how repeated addition and skip counting are related to multiplication facts.
