Every Friday we will have a spelling test on these words. Please practice these words every night at home so your child knows how to spell them and read them in a "snap". Please make sure to practice with your child how to use the word in a sentence and what the contractions mean.

Literacy: This week we will be reviewing contractions, compound words, similes as well as nouns, verbs and adjectives. Please take the time to go over these words with your child and what each means. Students should be reading each night and using Raz Kids.

Writing: This week we will be creating a book from a small moment about our Holiday experiences/memories. Your child will be showing their writing goal as well as how to begin with a sound word (onomatopoeia), someone speaking or a question. They will also be ending their story using either a question or a circular ending. Students at this point should be using similes in their writing as well as beginning to use dialogue.

Math: We have begun our unit on data analysis and students are collecting data and learning how to record it by tallies, lists, line plots and this week we will learn how to record on bar graphs. Please have your child use IXL to practice math at home.

Social Studies: We are learning about different land forms in the Atlantic Provinces and will begin to learn about different types of bodies of water.
