Words of the Week:

We have completed all sight words for Grade 3. Please continue to practice these words at home nightly. Students need to know how to read and spell these words in a snap!

Math: We are continuing our unit in measurement this week. Students have been practicing how to tell time on an analog clock (a clock with hands). Have your child show you what they know. We are now beginning to measure objects by their length and width.

We will continue to practice our math facts each day. We are now practicing all facts learned this year (addition, subtraction, multiplication and division). Continue to practice each night. Students should be using IXL nightly to review concepts taught this year.

Literacy: This week we will continue to use some of our literacy time to work on and complete our Learning in Depth Projects. Please have your child complete assignments sent home each evening so we can use them during class time. We will also be working on prefixes and suffixes.

Writing: We are continuing to work on our memoirs this week. Our stories are starting to come together. Soon we will have a memoir book to share with you.
