Every Friday we will have a spelling test on these words. Please practice these words every night at home so your child knows how to spell them and read them in a "snap". Please make sure to practice with your child how to use the word in a sentence.

Literacy: This week we will be reviewing the silent letters e, gh, w, t and l. We will review nouns, introduce verbs and adjectives. Students will be completing many activities around the room to help them with these. We have finished "The Miraculous Journey of Edward Tulane" and are beginning a new book. Please ask your child about Edward Tulane. Ask for retell, what was your favourite part? Least favourite part? Would you read this book again?

Writing: This week we are continuing to work on our writing goals. We have discussed how to start stories with someone speaking, a question or using onomatopoeia (sound words). We are going to be looking at how to do a circular ending (going back to the beginning of the story) or ending with a question.

Math: We have finished our unit on place value and numbers to 1000. We will begin working on data analysis. This is a fun unit that involves data collection, graphing and analyzing data. We will be doing many activities in the classroom that involve collecting data and placing it into graphs.
