We will be working on the following outcomes this month:

Literacy:

Reading Strategy: "Self-Monitoring" When reading, students must learn to think about their reading and to fix their own mistakes. If they insert their own word that isn't there or read the word incorrectly, it is important that they realize this on their own, go back and reread so that it makes sense.

Reading Fluency Focus: Commas Students will begin to notice punctuation more when they are reading. When we see a comma it means we pause when we are reading.

Writing Focus: Organization. Before beginning to write a story (pre-writing), it is important that your child know how to organize their thoughts and ideas. Students will learn to recognize and use Venn diagrams, plot organizers and story maps in prewriting.

Word Work/Sounds: Introducing adding endings: ed, ing when dropping silent "e", changing "y" to "i" and doubling final consonants.

Word Awareness: Review homophones, synonyms and antonyms

Math:

Unit 2: Numbers to 1000

Students will be expected to: →represent and describe numbers to 1000 \rightarrow find the meaning of place value for numerals to 1000 \rightarrow compare and order numbers to 1000 \rightarrow count by 5s, 10s, 25s and 100s to 1000 using any starting point \rightarrow skip counting and representing numbers with coins

 \rightarrow counting by 3s and 4s

→estimating to 1000

Science

 \rightarrow We will be finishing up our plants unit this month and beginning social studies.

Social Studies

How can you describe the province of New **Brunswick?**

 \rightarrow Describe the major physical features, climates and vegetation of their province and the Atlantic region.

 \rightarrow Examine where people live and how people make a living in their province
