What we are learning:

- New sight words this week: MOM, DAD and UP. All of the Red and Orange list words have now been introduced. Please continue to practice the other sight words covered this year as well.
- The students have been doing really well with the sight word colour lists and they seem excited about learning more all the time. Thank you for your continued help at home.
- Introduce the TH sound: (two letters that make one sound together) ie. Thursday, The, This, etc. We will also review the CH and SH sounds.
- We will continue to work on the reading strategies this week: **Eagle Eye** ~ Eagle Eye reminds us to look at the picture clues to help read the story & **Lips the Fish** ~ Lips the Fish reminds us to look at the beginning sound in an unknown word by getting our lips ready for the first letter. These two strategies are often used together to help the child decode an unknown word by both looking at the picture and the beginning letter to figure out/guess the unknown word (ie: rug vs mat; puppy vs dog etc.)
- In Writing, we will be putting more of a focus on adding that beginning sentence to our drawings by adding a beginning, middle and ending sound when possible. (Or just a beginning sound for those not quite ready for all the sounds) We are also working on putting finger spaces between the words we write to make it easier for someone to read.
- We will continue to work on sounding out CVC words (separating the sounds they hear) IE, chat ch a t
- In math this week, we finish up with the outcome: Compare quantities 0-10, using one to one correspondence. We will give the students a small assessment near the end of the week to make sure everyone understands more and fewer, as well as, being able to make sets/groups that are more, fewer or equal to another set
- You & Your World: This month we will focus on Self Control as our team trait.
