WILLIAM ALBERT BAMFORD AND ANNIE MARY JANE MITCHELL MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP

The estate of Louise Mitchell Bamford has established a Trust Fund., on behalf of the Bamford & Mitchell families of Doaktown, N.B. A scholarship, established in 2009, is to be awarded to full time students **pursuing a post-secondary university education.**

Eligibility

Applicants must:

- Attend Central New Brunswick Academy, with preference awarded to a student who resides within the boundaries of the catchment area of the previous Doaktown Consolidated High School, as they were in existence in June 2010.
- Achieve an average of at least eighty percent on university preparatory courses achieved in Grades 11 (11 credits) and the first semester of grade 12 (5 credits). Midterm marks for second semester of grade 12 may be considered when necessary.
- Write a 500 word typed essay explaining their academic achievements, school and community involvement, educational plans and financial need.
- Provide two letters of recommendation from educators who can outline the student's achievements in various aspects of school and community activities.

Funding

- An amount of \$1000.00 will be awarded and renewed for an additional three years if a minimum of a B average is maintained each year.
- Payment will be made directly to the university to be applied against the student's tuition fees.
- Half of the awarded amount will be issued at the beginning of each term upon submission of confirmation of the students' full-time enrollment to the appropriate School Board Office (currently District 18). Full time is defined as taking a minimum of five courses each term.
- Payment of the second installment is dependent upon the student attaining a minimum of a C average on first term courses.
- Confirmation of the academic standing of the student must be obtained by the School Board Office from the appropriate University Registrar at the end of each term.
- Should extenuating circumstances interrupt the student's academic career, requalification may occur at the discretion of the Selection Committee.

Submission Date

Applications for the scholarship must be submitted to the Principal by May 22, 2020. Selection will be made before the end of May and the successful candidate will be presented the award at the graduation ceremonies.
