



CNBA CURLING/SKATING DAY

On Tuesday, December 18, 2018, grades 6 – 8 students will be going to Doaktown to participate in a skating/curling day. Last week, the Rocks and Rings program was at CNBA to teach the students the rules of curling and to practice sweeping/throwing rocks. We are going to practice our new skills on real ice. As a district policy, students participating in events that involve icy surfaces are required to wear a helmet, even for curling. Bicycle helmets are permissible, but every student participating in curling and skating must have a helmet. Since we expect many students to be attending this event, we are dividing them up into teams. Some will be curling, some will be skating, and some will be doing activities off the ice. We will also be eating lunch at the rink, and the canteen will be open. Students are welcome to purchase their lunch, or bring their own lunch.
