Upon becoming aware of the threat, the police were immediately notified and took the necessary steps to deal with the situation. It was later determined that there were no weapons involved.

The district response team immediately began working with our school to assess the threat, provide support, and address any concerns among students and staff.

Our school is committed to the safety and security of all our students. Please be assured that your child's safety is our highest priority. All threats to our school or students are taken seriously and investigated thoroughly. It has been determined there is no safety issue for students and the school may continue with normal operations. Appropriate measures and actions are being taken to maintain a safe and secure school environment.

When there is an issue of concern, we want to clearly communicate with parents and provide as much information and clarity as possible. I truly apologize if a previous message issued on the day of the incident did not effectively reach all parents.

Central New Brunswick Academy is a great school and by working together to overcome challenging situations, we can do our best to ensure the safety and security of our children.

As we move forward, please remind your student to report any threats toward the school, students or staff to school staff as per outlined in the Fair Notice letter issued at the beginning of each school year or through PSST World ([www.psstworld.com](http://www.psstworld.com)).

We will reach out to you immediately if we have any further concerns. If your child requires support at school, please have them reach out to a member of our school staff.
