- Policy calls for the Superintendent to inform the District Education Council (DEC) of
 potential changes to program offerings, grade level configurations, school boundaries
 and school facilities. The policy also calls for the Superintendent to report on
 enrolment projections and functional capacity ratings. Also included in the policy is
 the responsibility of DEC to appoint a project team to investigate potential changes
 related to the Superintendent reports and recommendations as well taking into
 account capital construction priorities and transportation implications.
- Currently, in Anglophone West School District, there are 69 schools.
- There are 13 schools in ASD-W that house a total of 31 modular classrooms. Those schools include: Connaught Street Elementary School (1), Devon Middle School (2), Florenceville Elementary School (2), Forest Hill Elementary School (1), Gagetown School (3), Gibson-Neill Memorial Elementary School (3), Harvey Elementary School (1), Keswick Ridge School (2), Leo Hayes High School (8), Liverpool Street Elementary School (3), Montgomery Street Elementary School (1), Nashwaaksis Memorial Elementary School (1) and Priestman Street Elementary School (3). In the summer of 2017, ASD-W will see the addition of 9 modular classrooms at Barker's Point Elementary School (1), Garden Creek Elementary School (1), Montgomery Street Elementary School (1), Gibson-Neill Memorial Elementary School (2), Priestman Street Elementary School (1) and Nashwaaksis Memorial Elementary School (3). One modular classroom will be removed from Gagetown School.

- The consulting firm Ernst & Young conducted and presented a study on the Fredericton City Southside School demographics. The findings were presented publically on October 24, 2016. Recommendations of two new schools (Hanwell and Skyline Acres Neighborhood) replacing three schools (Kingsclear Elementary School, Forest Hill Elementary School and Liverpool Street Elementary School) would benefit our district, including a significant relief to high functional capacity ratings as the three elementary schools in question. It was also recommended that a third new school on Fredericton's Southside be on the radar for the not-too-distant future and that the district explore the K-2 and 3-5 catchment model for students of Connaught Street Elementary School and Montgomery Street Elementary School. Immediate reaction to the report was for Council to place the building of a new school in Hanwell as the #2 major capital construction priority for the district. The K-2 and 3-5 scenario for this recommendation and potentially other combinations within the district will be explored in the future. There is evidence within ASD-W that this works well. Council will need to think about the Skyline Acres Neighborhood School idea in the near future.
- Among the 69 schools, there are 103 combined classes (comparable to 104 last year)
 plus one setting with multi-age classes throughout the school (Keswick Ridge School).
 These classes are found in 47 of the 61 schools that are not pure 9-12 high schools
 (there are 8 pure high schools).
- Among the 69 schools, the following configurations are found: K-1 (1), K-2 (3), 2-5 (1), 3-5 (2), K-5 (25), K-8 (9), K-12 (6), 6-8 (9), 6-12 (5) and 9-12 (8) (Appendix A). The schools are divided into 3 Education Centers Woodstock, Oromocto and Fredericton. For operational purposes in balancing workload and level of service, 5 Fredericton City schools are served by staff associated with the Oromocto Education Center (Appendix B).
- ASD-W has 35 schools in the K-12 system that host students who have entered French Immersion in either grade 1 or grade 3 (Early). There are 16 schools in the 6-12 system that host students who have entered French Immersion in grade 6 (Late). Some of these schools host both programs.
- Beginning in 2017-18, the Early French Immersion entry point will return to Grade 1.
 Staff are working hard to ensure a smooth transition to this provincial mandate. In September, 2016, we had 747 students enrolled in Grade 3 French Immersion, the current entry point (of 1737 Grade 3 students, 43%). At this point in time, there are 550 of 1645 students registered for Grade 1 entry in 2017-18 and 577 of 1696 students registered for Grade 3 entry in 2017-18 (total of 33.7% for early immersion entry).

 Registration remains open and will likely climb as September, 2017 nears.
- Enrolment numbers follow an annual, official date of September 30th. In 2016-17, the ASD-W official enrolment is 22 901 students (up 27 students from 22 874 in 2015-16) (Appendix C).

- ASD-W has registered 279 international students through its Newcomer Support Centre from August 22, 2016 to January 23, 2017, with students coming from 30 different countries. Registrations will be steady as the second semester begins and continue throughout the year as families arrive.
- The Functional Capacity Rating is a percentage that describes the enrolment in comparison with available classroom space. The 2016-17 Functional Capacity values are found in Appendix D. Functional Capacity ratings less than 60% would suggest that there is available space in the building. Capacity ratings above 80% would suggest that the school is fairly full based on space available.
- There were 4 sustainability studies in 2015-16 (McAdam Elementary School, Burton Elementary School, Millville Elementary School and the three Nackawic schools as a cluster), resulting in the closure of Millville Elementary School and the status quo in the other three scenarios.
- A catchment area review was conducted by DEC and staff for the Leo Hayes High School catchment area, in an effort to decrease enrolment pressure at the school and in follow-up to the Leo Hayes High School Ernst & Young Report. A plan was confirmed in May, 2016, by DEC but then reviewed in the Fall of 2016 by the Superintendent and his team, with recommendations made and a final conclusion at tonight's meeting.
- There has been some interest shown by community stakeholders to make use of various schools in the district through reciprocal agreements. This interest continues to grow.
- The Facilities Department continues to monitor buildings in an effort to manage minor repairs and track possibilities for capital improvement projects.

Facilities Department

Functional Capacity Definitions

Original Classroom Space – an average sized space in the school that can be used as a teaching space with a maximum allotment of students.

Music – a room the school has deemed as the music room. This room may or may not include sound proofing, risers, and acoustic panels.

Art – a teaching space, approximately the size of a classroom or slightly larger, that is used primarily for Art in the school.

Library – a room designated for the school library, it may be a specially designed space or originally built as a classroom.

Resource/Literacy – a teaching space, approximately half the size of the average classroom, which can be used for smaller groups of students.

Broad Based Technology/Computer Lab – a teaching space with multiple computer work stations.

Home Economics – a teaching space with kitchenette(s) specifically designed for this purpose.

Automotive Lab – a teaching space with optional hoists and open vehicles bays.

Carpentry Lab – a teaching space with carpentry tools and workshop space.

Science Lab – a classroom equipped with sinks, tables and counters for experiment purposes.

Gymnasium – a large multi-purpose room or full gymnasium used for the purpose of playing games.

Cafeteria – a seating area for a portion/all of the students during lunch periods.

Office – a space for the office area which may include a reception area, admin assistant space, Principal and Vice-Principals office.

Staff Room, Lounge, Workroom – a working space possibly shared with working tables, copier, seating area and possible kitchenette.

Classroom Capacity – for the ease of calculation these factors are used for consideration of the maximum capacity within the classrooms in the various school grade configurations:
