Interpretation:

- **Policy requires the Superintendent to ensure the District Education Council has all relevant information required to make decisions regarding the effective use of schools.**
- **District Education Council is required under the Education Act to prioritize the Capital Improvement list for ASD-W. The list is submitted to the Department of Education and Early Childhood.**
- **District Education Council is responsible for determining where Sustainability and Feasibility studies are to be completed within ASD-W.**

Justification:

- **The District Education Council has the authority under the Education Act 2(1-3), 3(1-2) & 3.1 to establish, operate and propose closure of schools in Anglophone West School District.**
- **The District Education Council has the responsibility under the Education Act 36.9(5-i) to submit a report that identifies priorities respecting capital construction projects within the school district on an annual basis.**
- **The District Education Council (DEC) has the responsibility under the Education Act 45(2) that the DEC, at all times, have management, care and control of all school property in the school district for which the DEC is established, until such time as the school property is declared surplus by the DEC.**
- **The Superintendent has the responsibility under the Education Act 48(1) to be accountable to the District Education Council concerned for the management of programs and resources for the quality of learning.**
- **In the Education Act 11(1), the superintendent concerned shall determine the placement of pupils in classes, grades, programs, services and schools according to the needs of the pupils and the resources of the school district.**
- **EECD Policy 409 (3) states that Grade level configurations refers to the addition or removal of an entire grade level or levels from a school.**
- **EECD Policy 409 6.1, 6.2, 6.4, 6.5, 6.6, 6.7 & appendices A, B, C establishes criteria for Multi-Year Infrastructure Planning requirements, grade reconfiguration and criteria for looking at school sustainability.**

FRENCH LEARNING OPPORTUNITIES FOR RURAL AREAS (FLORA).

The Department of Education and Early Childhood Development introduced a new opportunity for K–3 elementary school children to learn French in rural areas. This program is for the early grades in rural schools with no access to French Immersion.

Year 1 of the pilot was 2017-18 at one elementary school in ASDW.

This creative, new program introduces children to their second official language in a new way. Supported by a teacher, students learn French, for thirty minutes daily, through fun digital modules.

The modules are accessible to parents through their personal computer or a tablet borrowed from school so that they and their child can read, sing and play along. The main characters, Rigolo and Rigolette, engage children as they learn French. The activities are designed to reinforce literacy and numeracy skills that children are learning in English in their daily practice in another program. Rigolo and Rigolette provide context and this will stretch their imagination and deepen their learning.

All students K-3 participate in French Language and culture learning experiences for 30 minutes weekly.

Grades 4-10, students participate in Pre-Intensive (Grade 4 ; 150 minutes per week), Intensive (Grade 5; one term 1000 minutes per week, and second term 150 minutes per week) and Post-Intensive (Grades 6-10; grades 6-8 ; 200 minutes per week , and grades 9-10 one course per year)

Grade 11-12 students have optional courses, including on-line available to them.


