In accordance with section 6.1.1 of Policy 409, Anglophone West School District is submitting our Multi-Year Infrastructure plan along with our Major Capital Priorities and Study list for 2019-2020 for the Minister of Education and Early Childhood Development's consideration.

Major Capital Priorities are:

1. Oromocto High School Mid-Life Upgrade
2. New K-5 in the Killarney Lake area
3. New K-5 Combined school for Nashwaaksis Memorial Elementary and McAdam Avenue Elementary
4. New K-5 Combined school for Forest Hill Elementary and Liverpool St Elementary
5. Woodstock High School Mid-Life Upgrade
6. Replacement school for Devon Middle School
7. Replacement school for George Street Middle School
8. 3 New K-8 Schools to replace 7 existing schools in the Oromocto Area. (Burton, Assiniboine, Harold Peterson, Hubbard, Gesner, Summerhill and Ridgeview)
9. New K-8 school to replace configuration of schools in the Carleton North Catchment areas for 3 schools in Florenceville-Bristol and possibly could include Bath Community School to be determined once a decision has been made with respect to Bath Community School's future.
10. Combine Minto High with Minto Elem/Middle (ask for building assessment to ensure this is best solution, Combine Chipman Elementary in with Chipman Forest Avenue (ask for a building assessment to ensure this is best solution)
11. Leo Hayes High School: Shop and Skill Trades Addition and Renovation

Major Capital Mid-Life Projects: Mid-Life Studies Required

1. Nashwaaksis Middle School
2. Kingsclear Consolidated School

Feasibility Facility Studies Requested are:


1. Plaster Rock Schools Study
