-602 students this year, the school is at maximum capacity and 16 new teachers to welcome to the team.

-New Tech teacher Mr. Graham is revamping the tech space and has enlisted the help of student volunteers to help upgrade the space.

-DMS went to virtual learning for one day last month due to a case at the school. It was very last minute notice but the teachers did an amazing job, and have learned alot about how it will look if it happens again.

-Stuff a bus campaign to support the breakfast program will be on October 23rd this year at 10-5 at the Giant Tiger on Union Street

-School goals for the year include, support for literacy with more reading time in english LA classes, putting focus on academics and learning issues, rather than, behavioral issues and supporting staff and students in this way, and increasing percentage of students who "feel safe" at school by at least 10% as recorded by the data system.
