- Located in the central-northwest portion of New Brunswick; covers 1/3 of the province.
- Geographic Area: 30,463 sq. km. (approx.)
- Covering communities as far north as Edmundston and as far south as Cambridge Narrows including Grand Falls, Plaster Rock, Perth-Andover, Bath, Florenceville-Bristol, Centreville, Hartland, Woodstock, Canterbury, Nackawic, Harvey, McAdam, Keswick Ridge, Burtt's Corner, Stanley, Boiestown, Doaktown, Nashwaak Valley, Fredericton, New Maryland, Oromocto, Lincoln, Fredericton Junction, Geary, Burton, Gagetown, Minto and Chipman.
