Description:

Under the direction of the Subject Coordinator for Student Services, the Autism Resource Lead for Autism Intervention will be responsible for the following:

- Assist in setting priorities for the direct service of ABA trained Educational Assistants within the Education Centre.
- Assist schools with establishing and maintaining appropriate programming for students with Autism Spectrum Disorders. This may include incorporating strategies and techniques of Applied Behavior Analysis and writing appropriate programs.
- Maintain regular contact with school and home regarding programming for students with Autism Spectrum Disorders.
- Monitor the use of best practices and effective strategies (PECS, social stories, visual supports, etc.) for children with Autism Spectrum Disorders.
- Provide applicable staff with ongoing program development support, training, and professional development opportunities related to best practices for teaching and working with children with Autism Spectrum Disorders.
- Provide Educational Assistants with hands-on training and professional development opportunities to further their growth process with strategies specific to children with Autism Spectrum Disorders.
- Serve as a district liaison to specific schools and attend student services meetings at these schools.
- Attend planning meetings (PATH, case conference, transition, etc.) for children with Autism Spectrum Disorders.
- Attend regularly-scheduled Student Services Team meetings as well as Education Centre Student Services meetings.
- Provide direct literacy interventions based on the Pyramid of Interventions developed by the school team for students deemed to be at risk
- Work in collaboration with Administration, Literacy Leads and Resource and Methods in planning, goal setting, frequent monitoring and assessing students in intervention.
- Assist in the collection and interpretation of literacy data gathered during interventions

Qualifications:

- Minimum – Master’s of Education Exceptionalities, Teacher’s Certificate VI.
- Experience as a Resource and Methods teacher would be an asset.
- Success completion of UNB College of Extended Learning Clinical Supervisor program or equivalent.
- Demonstrated Exemplary Classroom Best Practices.
- Demonstrated Leadership, Organizational and Presentation Skills.
- Interpersonal Skills, with clear commitment to a Team Approach.
- Problem Solving Ability.
