KINDERGARTEN REGISTRATION FOR THE 2013-2014 SCHOOL YEAR

WHEN AND WHERE TO REGISTER

Registration of children who will enter Kindergarten in September 2013 will be conducted **from**October 9 – 12, 2012, at your local school from 8:30 a.m. to 4:00 p.m.* Anglophone West School

Districts includes all schools in the former Districts 14, 17, and 18. This enrollment enables the school
district to prepare adequately for the fall term and offer readiness activities for both the parents and
child throughout the year. Students should be registered at their zone school. For parents unable to
register at their zone school during that week, children may be registered at the local education centres
at the following times:

Oromocto Education Centre 17 Miramichi Road, Oromocto	Thursday, October 11	4:00 – 8:00 PM
Fredericton Education Centre 1135 Prospect Street, Fredericton	Wednesday, October 17	5:00 – 8:00 PM

^{*}Please note that for students entering kindergarten at Lincoln Elementary School, registration will take place at Gesner Street Elementary School in Oromocto.

STUDENTS ENTERING KINDERGARTEN

Kindergarten attendance is compulsory for all children who reach the age of five years on or before September 1, 2013. Children who reach the age of five years between September 2nd and December 31st, 2013, inclusive, are eligible to begin Kindergarten in September 2013, but attendance is not compulsory. Parents of these children may defer the entry into Kindergarten of these children until September 2014.

REQUIREMENTS FOR REGISTRATION

PARENTS MUST PRESENT THE FOLLOWING required information at their zone school to enroll a child for the 2013-2014 school year:

- Proof of age (Birth Certificate, Passport, or Immigration Papers)
- The child's **Medicare Number**
- Proof of Immunization is required by the Health Act and Education Act for all students entering school for the first time in NB. Please provide an Immunization Card or letter from the Doctor.
