What We will Learn this Week

Literacy- This week we will be doing lots of reading and writing activities related to our study of Mexico and to the lifecycle of the monarch butterfly.

Sight words for the week- fill, full, most, least, and hold.

Phonics "Wh" revisiting the question words who, what, when, where and why.

Writing: Non-fiction writing (reports) including a table of contents.
