IMPORTANT DETAILS/INSTRUCTIONS

Please find attached photos of the school grounds and school interior. Please bring your name card with you on graduation day (the one you received when you pick up your cap & gown) as you will be required to show it to staff on two occasions (Station A and Station G). If you have misplaced your name card, please write your FULL NAME on a piece of card stock, and bring it with you.

On graduation day, you will proceed as follows:

- Arrive at the main administrative entrance off Priestman Street on the specified date and time listed above. Proceed to Station A and show your name card to FHS staff at this station. There is a maximum of two cars per grad allowed past this point – please ensure both cars arrive at the same time.
- Proceed to Station B and follow staff direction into the student parking lot to park your vehicle. All graduates and guests will exit their vehicle and proceed to the main school administration entrance (Station C). While on school property, everyone must wear a mask.
- From Station C, you will be directed to move into the building. Please remember to sanitize your hands upon entry into the building (Station D).
- Follow the direction of staff to move throughout the building (Station E, Station F).
- At Station G, present your name card to staff. Those students who have qualified for an honours chord will receive it at this station. At this point, graduates will separate from their families.
- Parents will follow the green arrow as indicated on the interior map and will have the opportunity to take photos of their graduate (station H).
- Students will follow the blue arrow as indicated on the interior map. At this point, students may remove their masks, while maintaining physical distancing from the other graduates in line.
- Just prior to taking the stage, the graduate will display their name card to the Vice-Principal at the podium at the bottom of the stairs (Station I) to be announced.
- Once the graduates' name is called, they will ascend the stairs to the stage, receive their diploma and pause to allow for photos to occur (Station J).
