IMPORTANT DETAILS/INSTRUCTIONS

Please find attached photo of a map of the school grounds. Please bring your name card with you on graduation day (the one you will receive when you pick up your cap & gown) as you will be required to show it to staff on three occasions (Station A, Station E and Station G)

On graduation day, you will proceed as follows:

- Arrive at the main administrative entrance off Priestman Street on the specified date and time listed above. Proceed to Station A and show your name card to FHS staff at this station. There is a maximum of two cars per grad (please arrive at the same time) allowed past this point.
- Proceed to Station B and follow staff direction into the student parking lot (Station C) to be lined up. All
 graduates and guests are to remain with their vehicles while in this parking lot as per provincial
 regulations on mass gatherings.
- From the student parking lot (Station C), you will be directed when to move into the graduation area in front of the school (Station D).
- At Station E, the graduate will exit the car and show his/her name card to the communications staff person. The graduate's family will move slowly in vehicle(s) as directed to Station F in front of the stage.

 One family member is permitted to exit a vehicle to take photos.
- The graduate will then proceed along the red carpet (while respecting 2m distance markings) toward the stage/VP Podium (Station G).
- Just prior to taking the stage, the graduate will display their name card to the Vice-Principal at the podium at the bottom of the stairs (Station G) to be announced.
- The Vice-Principal will read the name of the graduate, who will then proceed up and across the stage toward the table in front of Mrs. Tomilson (Station H).
- The graduate will collect their diploma from the table in front of Mrs. Tomilson and pause on the marked spot for photos by family members.
- The graduate will exit the stage via stairs and collect their graduation gift bag from the table (Station I).
- The graduate will continue along the red carpet and rejoin their families to exit the grounds (Station J).
