Who we are:

- East Coast Community Care is a locally owned clothing and household collection company, based out of Saint John New Brunswick. This program creates additional revenues for Non-Profit organizations through the effective collection and sales of clothing here in Atlantic Canada. East Coast is owned by Derek MacFarlane and Trevor Edwards, both who have years of experience in the clothing collection business. This corporate social enterprise was established as a means of creating a long term partnership with local non-profits in Atlantic Canada. Some of our partners include: Big brothers Big sisters, The Joshua Group, The Canadian Diabetes Association, Cat Rescue Maritimes, Meals on Wheels, Fresh Start for women, MS Society, Bibles for Missions, Backpacks for the homeless and many others.
- Through our new 2016 clothing donation bin program launched in Saint John, as well as our local gold rush style “Bounty” weekly tag draw we have raised over \$95,000 dollars to date for non-profits in Atlantic Canada with a 2017 target of over \$175,000
- East Coast Community Care and affiliates currently employs over 50 local New Brunswick residents has 3 full time collection vehicles and over 100 Donation bins helping a variety of non-profit groups throughout New Brunswick with expansion plans in 2017 of over 300 Donation Bins throughout Atlantic Canada.
- The clothing from the donation bins are dispersed in a number of fashions while strictly adhering to a near zero environmental impact strategy. In order to cover the costs to the program, clothing is sold both locally while some is exported. In addition; much of this product is donated to non-profit groups, as well we take much of the ripped and stained items are made into rags and sold to local shops.

Letter of Understanding - Site requirements and Maintenance

Please be advised that East Coast Community Care has agreed to, without exception, maintain the immediate clothing donation bin site (and 20 feet around the bins), including plowing, salt and sanding as required. East Coast is responsible for the removal of all garbage, waste and other clothing donation bins from the site within 7 days of placement, at the cost to East Coast Community Care, and agrees to continually maintain the property twice a day or as pickups are required to insure that the property is kept in pristine condition at all times. If at any time the site is not in keeping with the standards of your organization we will remove the clothing donation bins within 24 hours.
