

POSTING AND RELEASE OF STUDENT INFORMATION – Grades 9 to 12

In an effort to enhance communication with parents, guardians and students, ASD-W has initiated the PowerSchool Public Portal. This will allow parents, guardians and students to view current student attendance data, detailed course descriptions, school bulletins, and updates from the teacher in a secure online environment.

Student information that would be accessible by parents and students would include student progress & assessment results, homework assignments & reporting, historical grades, demographic information and school-related events & notifications. You will only be able to view information for a student or students for whom you have been issued a Student Access ID & password by the School Administration.

Please note: While stringent security protocols are enforced to mitigate the risk of unintentionally exposing student information to the internet, any information hosted on websites or e-mailed has the potential to be viewed/accessed by other Internet users. Parents & students are advised to consider this possibility and strictly adhere to the *Acceptable Computer Use Policy* guidelines.
