


## Music At Home K-2




Activity #1 Read the poem below with your family and keep a steady beat with some homemade rhythm instruments. (Two wooden spoons would work just fine for this activity) Grade 1 students can then try reading it a second time and tap the rhythm (The way the words go or word syllables) Grade 2 students can try writing the rhythm of the poem. It includes to it and Tah. (Quarter notes and Eighth notes) As an added challenge you can write your own poems and try to figure out the rhythm and beat!
