# Report from DEC Representative: Stephanie Haslam, report sent via email

- Sustainability studies (4 schools identified) part of DEC mandate for this year
- Spring Symposium canceled due to flooding, rescheduled November 2, 3, 4
- One seat left per sub-district, if interested in attending notify Al or Katherine by Sept 28
- Stephanie will update on DEC goals for the year at October meeting

## **Examples of PSSC Carry Over Items from 2017-2018:**

- 1. Outdoor Classroom opportunity for students to get outdoors, incorporate into curriculum
- 2. <u>Community Garden</u> Lily Smallwood Grade 3/4 split class harvested summer vegetables
  - teachers can approach Lily with ideas, incorporate the Garden into their curriculum
  - "Farm to Table" looking for schools with established gardens, Katherine will forward email to Lily
- 3. Feeder School PSSC Interaction –networking among local PSSC Chairs in the area
  - George Street Feeder School PSSC chairs did end up meeting in 2018; put voice together to DEC, bring parent views to the DEC
  - Chair of the DEC also invited all the PSSC chairs to meet and foster communication between PSSCs within the district, education department, school councils
- 4. Portal for PSSC Member Log-in to maintain working documents
  - on DEC agenda, includes ways to share documents, will learn more from Stephanie

#### **Report from the Principal:**

#### Current academic and activity items:

- <u>Survey Monkey</u> communication is of high importance to families, led to teachers sending memos, using see-saw, increased parent-teacher connection
- families also interested in large group gatherings eg multi-cultural night, career fair invite parents as resources, fits with 10 year plan, students think about future potential
- Multi-Cultural Association may come in fall and present to students

- Time to re-do parent survey? New issues may have arisen
- Core Leadership Teacher Group meets approx. 6 weeks, work on SIP,
- this week district personnel will come in to work on positive behavior intervention and support (PBIS) for students; playground expectations, safe zones, equipment use, supervision
- <u>School Improvement Plan</u> ongoing, e.g. formative assessment, building student voice and choice (leadership group meets with students), collective efficacy (teams and teachers working together, PLC's meeting to work with students in classroom
- <u>Professional Learning</u> topics connectedness and cultural responsiveness, including First Nations
- Clubs spelling bee's, flag football, chess, coding, Caring for Critters
- Literacy Lead here until December K- Grade 3 this year
- Training in math K-3's and new teachers
- <u>ELF (Early Literacy Foundation)</u> program has 4 volunteers that work with grade 2 students after school
- After school art, robotics lego to come in January
- Second portable no longer needed for classroom space, may be used for class next year
- Savage's donating two bikes to school, requested picture, will provide image just of bike not students
- Updating website, common area for teacher pages

What's Happening at the Creek Update - please see creek update for September 2018 for details, will be on website, note bazaar, Christmas concert, upcoming PL days

**Staffing** – 16 classrooms with no pending changes

- part-time librarian covering library until Rebecca's return
- grade 5 teacher will be on Maternity leave approx. March, will secure replacement

## Policy 711 – Healthier School Food Environment

- No major changes aside from hot lunch, pizza to conform with policy, lunch now includes applesauce
- Chartwells will continue on Thursdays, not quite running yet
- Can use snacks remaining in office, but replace with snacks conform to policy

Flouride: - Waiting on materials to arrive, coordinating volunteers

**PSSC Budget -** \$900 in budget – for communication to parents

- Past usage includes paper, signage, other options to explore such as fridge magnets for families, put toward a multi cultural night
- Garden Creek School sign at back of school maybe a new sign along FRONT of school that's more visible, possibly apply for grant to fund this
