## • Treasurer's Report

- o Current balance ~\$11,000
- o Expenses:

- Outstanding deposits:
  - Scott's Nursery ~\$60
  - Mabel's Labels ~\$60
  - Garden Creek Garden Club Loan \$4,000 (to be repaid in March 2021)
- o Total balance after expenses: ~\$9,700
- Reserved monies \$8,000 (garden loan + \$4,000 in account for beginning of next school year)
- o Total current available funds ~\$1,700
- o Need to make more money before we can do any further spending!
