### Morning Drop-off/Afternoon Pick-up

As we progress into the Fall, our students should be settling into their morning routines. We kindly ask that when dropping off your child between 7:40-8:10am, you remind them to walk on the yellow crosswalk lines to our playground.

Traffic flow: We ask that you maintain a steady but slow pace of vehicle movement after drop-off while watching the crosswalk. This is essential to a safe startup. Duty teachers are on site to assist/guide you.

At dismissal, please stand on the yellow line near the sidewalk leading into our playground before walking your child to the parking lot or off the school grounds.

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### Lice Prevention

- Hair clips/accessories
- Hats/bike helmets
- Scarves/coats
- Towels

We encourage you to discuss preventative measures with your children.

We are a peanut/nut free school due to several allergies in our school. Nutella is also not permitted in our school.

All staff and students are asked to refrain from wearing scented products. These can trigger allergic responses.
