Appropriate Dance Behaviors

All school rules apply during school dances. Attending dances is a privilege which must be earned by students. Dances are from 6:30 to 8:30 pm in the gymnasium and the Student Representative Council charges a \$5.00 entrance fee.

- a. Students must behave in a respectful manner. This includes respect toward others and respect toward materials within our school.
- b. Students must keep their hands and feet to themselves. (This includes appropriate dancing) We do not accept bumping and grinding.
- c. Students must attend school/classes on the day of the dance in order to be permitted into the dance.
- d. No student is to go up the stage nor should any student sit or climb onto the stage. Students can only be in the lower part of the bleachers on the left. Jackets and coats will be placed on the right of the lower bleachers.
- e. If a student chooses to leave the dance, they are <u>NOT</u> permitted to re-enter.
- f. Students are only permitted to leave the dance when a parent or guardian is visible. Students should be picked up promptly at 8:30 pm. We ask that parents not enter the gymnasium during and after the dance.
- g. The administration and staff of George Street Middle School reserve the right to refuse entrance to the dance.
- h. All students must be at the dance by 7:00 pm unless given prior permission by administration.
- i. Sign-ins must be in good standing (as recommended by their school) and must be from either grade 6, 7, or 8.
- j. Students cannot have a sign-in if they are arriving at the dance after 7:00 pm.
- k. Sign ins' are the responsibility of the signee and must follow all of the above rules.
- 1. No food/drink allowed in the gymnasium. Cafeteria will be open.
- m. Students will not be able to enter the dance with backpacks. We will store them in the resource room.
