We are very excited to launch our healthy, apple fundraising initiative. By partnering with River View Orchards we are able to buy local, sell local and support local.


Students will be selling tickets for yummy 3 lb bags of apples at \$5.00 per bag. These will be ready for pick up at the school on October 10<sup>th</sup> from 12 noon until 6 pm.

Following are some important 'things to remember' about our apple campaign:

- 1- Our apple bags will all be 3 pound bags. They will either be McIntosh, Cortland and Spartan. We do not guarantee a choice at the time of sale but customers may choose (while supplies last) on pick up day.
- 2- Customers have 2 methods of getting their apples and should select A or B on the ticket.
  - A- The customer will pick up apples at George Street Middle School on October 10th.
  - B- The <u>George Street parent will pick up the order and deliver them to the customer.</u>
    Please note, students are not able to take home more than 2 bags of apples by themselves. If a student has more than 2 bags to take home they should have a parent pick them up. We do this to help guarantee the quality of apples.
- 3- Purchase for donation option- If a customer would prefer to buy a bag to be donated to the Community Kitchen or Greener Village-Fredericton Food Bank, they can indicate this on the ticket. No pick up is necessary for donations. Last year we donated over \$1500 worth of apples and cash to our community partners. Our donation qualifies us to participate in the Community Kitchen Student Hunger Program that provides packed lunches.
- 4- The large/left side of the ticket and money should be returned to the school on the collection days. See dates below.
- 5- Customers are to keep the claim ticket on right side for the pick-up day on October 10<sup>th</sup>.
- 6- If a parent is picking up the apples for the customers, the parent should keep the claim ticket and pick up student orders on October 10<sup>th</sup>. \*\*VERY IMPORTANT\*\* If a student has multiple customers and the parent is picking them up, please keep a written list of customer names,# of bags and addresses.
- 7- Customers can pay by cash or cheque made payable to George Street Middle School.
- 8- Unsold tickets must be returned to the school. As we only printed a limited amount of tickets, please return tickets so others can sell.

## Prizes - What do I win?

- Every collection day we will have **prize draws** for people who sell apples
- Top 5 sellers will get a pass to our positive person movie. They can bring a friend and ride to the **theatre in a limousine.**
- The top class in the school will win a **downtown lunch** with \$5 each to spend.
- The top 15 sellers in the school will be invited to take some time off to go to the orchard.
- Classes with 100% participation will get to book some 'chill time' in the lounge to watch a movie.
- There will be a 'special' prize for meeting our overall school goal of \$12000. Submit your suggestion at the office

Oct 4<sup>th</sup> (Friday) – Fourth / Final collection day
\*\* Unsold tickets must be returned to homeroom teachers
