


Spring SPARK Booklet 2022

1. **GSMS School of Cycology**— It's spring and that means BICYCLES! Come for a great series of rides along our amazing trail network. Pace will be chill, but come dressed for the weather because we will be riding the whole time, and BRING A HELMET! We do have a limited supply of bikes if you can't get yours here or don't have one! Some time will also be spent talking about basic safety and some maintenance about your rig!

2. <u>Beach Volleyball- Beach Volleyball</u> is an opportunity for students to play and have fun in a recreational setting. Students should bring water, sunscreen, and clothing that is appropriate for the weather. Participants do not need to have previous volleyball experience to sign up. Please note, this is not for volleyball skill instruction but rather an opportunity to play and experience the game.

3. <u>Walk the Trails</u> - Enjoy taking in the scenery of beautiful Fredericton as we walk the trails around the downtown and across the bridge. We will stop for a treat on our last day (bring own change). Be prepared with comfortable walking shoes (flip flops and slides don't count) and a water bottle.

4. <u>Golf @ Kingswood</u> - The golf program will take place at Kingswood and will be taught by PGA of Canada Teaching Professionals Bari Gourley and Gordon Kay. This 4-week program will teach the FUNdamentals of the golf game. The first lesson will teach the skill of putting and the group will finish with a little contest. The second lesson will teach the "shortgame" where we will work on

chipping and pitching around the green. The third and fourth lessons will be on the driving range learning about the full swing using irons and driver. This program will be set in a fun and safe environment. If you have golf clubs, you will be able to drop them off the night before the SPARK. If you do not, clubs will be provided.

5. <u>Bouldering</u> - Want to learn how to rock climb? Come climb at the Fredericton Bouldering Coop! This rock climbing SPARK offers 30 minutes of instruction on climbing techniques and safety, followed by 30 minutes of climbing practice on their indoor bouldering walls. Students will be bused to the facility and back to the school. Rental shoes are included in the cost. Students must have their online waiver signed prior to participating (https://www.fbcwall.com/waivers).

6. <u>Tennis</u> - Students will travel by bus to the Abony Family Tennis Centre. Whether you are an experienced player or you simply want to try tennis for the first time, this is guaranteed to be a fun time! You will learn the basic fundamentals of how to play tennis, the rules of the game and play mini matches. **You will need non-marking sneakers, but you do not need your own racquet.

7. **Gym Games** - Students will get to practice different sports every week with this SPARK. Namely: indoor volleyball, Floorball, Ultimate Frisbee, pickle ball and more. Please bring indoor court shoes.

8. <u>Rugby</u> - Rugby is a fast paced, fun, and exciting sport that is played in more than 90 countries by over 7 million people, making it one of the most popular sports in the world. Through various games you will get to work on your passing, agility, and movement on the field. This will be friendly and more strategy based, and will not be full contact type rugby.

9. <u>Soccer Baseball</u> - We will be walking as a group over to Queen Square spending some time playing a few rounds of Soccer Baseball! All levels of experience welcome as this will simply be friendly competition. Students should be dressed for the weather/activity and have a water bottle.

10. <u>Fencing</u> - Learn the exciting sport of Olympic fencing! An introduction to the sport with games, footwork & plenty of fencing, ending with a team competition. Please dress comfortably in track pants and non-marking sneakers and bring a water bottle.

11. <u>Archery</u> – This is an introduction to the sport of archery. Students will learn the proper techniques and form from experienced archers. Students will get practice time and may even play in some friendly competitions among their peers.

Cost: \$34.25 Location: Archery Center (Industrial Park)

12. <u>Pickleball</u> - One of the fastest growing sports in North America involves a court and a net. Pickleball is something of a mix between tennis, racquetball, and ping pong. Players use special paddles and a wiffle ball, and games take place on tennis courts with specific pickleball lines. Nets and court sizes are smaller than their tennis counterparts, and the most common game is doubles, although singles is also an option. It has its own set of quirky rules — for instance, try to stay out of the "kitchen"— but they're easy to learn.

13. <u>Dance!</u> - Dance SPARK will offer classes in stretching, across the floor and choreography. Styles can be chosen based on interest, but can include jazz, ballet, lyrical and hip-hop. Students will be bused to Capital Dance Company Studio and will work with a dance instructor for their sessions.

Cost: \$5.50 Location: Capital Dance Company Studio on Prospect

14. <u>Cross Country</u> - Join us for an intermediate cross country run through downtown Fredericton. Each session we will be doing a warm-up, medium (5km) to long distance (7-10k) run and a cool down. High level of fitness and running endurance for at least 30 minutes or more required. Be sure to dress appropriately for the activity and bring a water bottle.

Cost: \$0 Location: Downtown Fredericton

15. <u>Skateboarding</u> - Come get rad and learn gnarly new tricks at Skateboard Spark! We will be travelling to the Garrison Skate Park for some fun under the sun. Be sure to bring your own skateboard and helmet. Helmets are mandatory. Catch ya there!

16. The Nest Yoga (Hot Yoga) - Do you like yoga? Join this SPARK and we will walk to The Nest Yoga studio at Kingsplace. The class will be suitable for beginning and experienced students. You will develop body awareness, learn basic postures and proper alignment. The studio will provide mats and towels for all students; however, you are free to bring your own if you prefer! Since it will be a warm class, a water bottle will be needed. This relaxing space will calm your mind. Get on your mat and get healthy!

17. <u>Beginner Guitar</u> - Are you interested in learning to play guitar? Are you somebody with little-to-no music experience? Then this is the perfect opportunity for you! Students will learn how to hold, tune, and play your first few chords on guitar. By the end, you will be able to play a song or two on guitar! This SPARK is not for those who already play guitar - beginners only, please! There will be no fee for those who have their own guitar. Those without a guitar will be required to pay \$5 to rent a guitar to use (arranged by the instructor).

18. <u>Clay Café</u> - Students will get to select their two choices of ceramic pieces to paint. At the end of the four weeks, pieces will be glazed and sent back to the school for the students to take home. (All supplies are provided by Clay Café for the price)

We will be spending four mornings at Games Unplugged downtown playing their huge selection of games. They have over 500 games of all genres and skill levels. Bring your friends and competitive spirit, it's time to put away those phones....it's board game time!

25. <u>Chess</u> - Do you play chess? Do you want to learn how to? If you said yes to either question, then this SPARK is for you! You will learn how to set the board, chess etiquette, the name of all pieces, how they move and strategies to help you begin and finish the game. You will also play against other students in a friendly in-class competition. All experience levels are welcome!

26. <u>Pokemon Go! Downtown Walk</u> - Bring your phone (You'll need data), get some raid passes, and get ready to walk through the downtown core looking for your favourite Pokemon. We'll target gyms and take get some Legendaries.

29. <u>Babysitting Course</u> - Do you have younger siblings? Do you like to care and play with younger children? Would you like to make make some spending money? If so, join Babysitting Spark to become a certified babysitter (age 11 and up). The Saint-John Ambulance instructors will be here to teach you everything you need to know about babysitting. At the end of the 4 weeks of SPARK you will have your babysitting certificate just in time for the summer months.

30. <u>Indigenous Drumming/Cultural SPARK -</u> Indigenous culture SPARK will offer a variety of activities that will teach about the beautiful teachings of the Wolastoqiyik people. This includes drumming, guest speakers, story-telling and crafts.

31. <u>Robotics @ Science East</u>— Students will work with circuit hardware to create a structure using LED lights. Groups will then use a coding language to control the effects of the light. Coding, engineering, and art design all in one project!

32. Exploring Technology Through the Ages - Has technology always had screens? What about buttons? Has technology always been electronic of some kind? In this SPARK program, we will become mini-archaeologists and try our best to make technology from more than 10 000 years ago - long before screens, buttons, or electronics. We will be learning how technology was made in the past and how we use technology today in archaeology. Students will make their own stone tools using ancient techniques and then using new technology, like the b.Board, students will create an invention that can help with modern-day archeological digs to help us learn more about the same ancient technologies we had previously explored.

33. Writing the Incredible Tale - The Mysterious Mr. M teaches you the secrets of incredible storytelling. By the end of the module you'll have a 24- or 32-page picture book manuscript. Furthermore, the priceless storytelling lessons will help you if you want to write novels, short
